This Gift Aid declaration allows Cambridge Rape Crisis Centre to reclaim tax back from the government on eligible donations. You confirm you are a UK taxpayer and understand that if you pay less Income Tax and/or Capital Gains Tax than the amount of Gift Aid claimed on all your donations in that tax year (6 April – 5 April) it is your responsibility to pay any difference. Cambridge Rape Crisis Centre will reclaim 25p on every £1 you donate from the government. Please note that Gift Aid cannot be claimed by one individual on money collected from multiple donors, e.g. birthday collections.
